

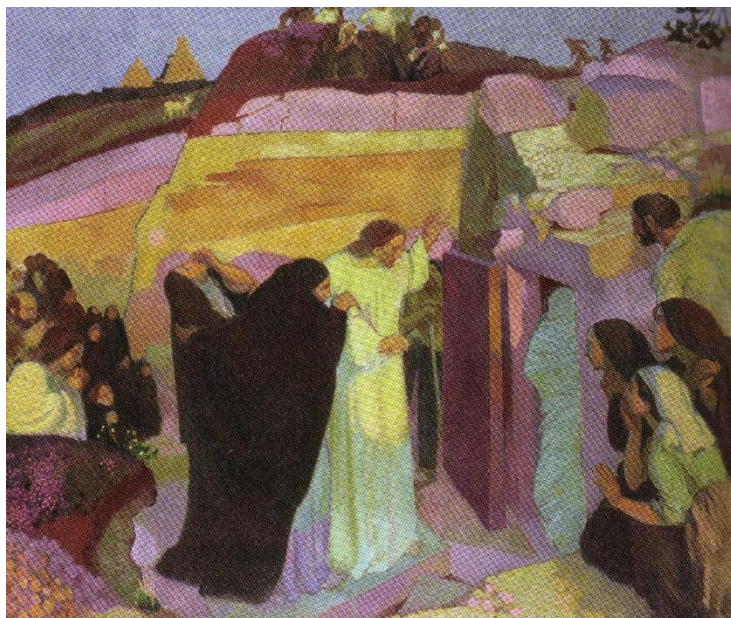

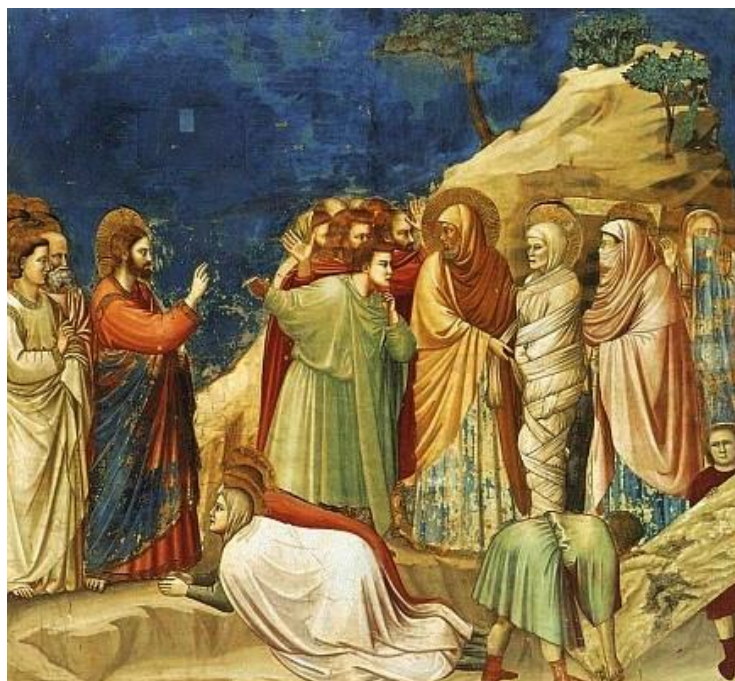
A reflection on today's story
